Individuals who are currently in the U.S. in the J-1 Exchange Visitor visa status and would like to transfer their J-1 SEVIS record to The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston (UTHealth Houston) must communicate this with their current J-1 sponsoring institution. If the Office of International Affairs (OIA) determines that the J-1 visa holder is eligible to transfer to UTHealth Houston, the RO/ARO (typically, the international advisor) at their current institution must release the J-1 SEVIS record to UTHealth Houston. OIA will not have access to the J-1 SEVIS record until the release date scheduled by the current institution. This form must be completed and signed by the J-1 visitor.
