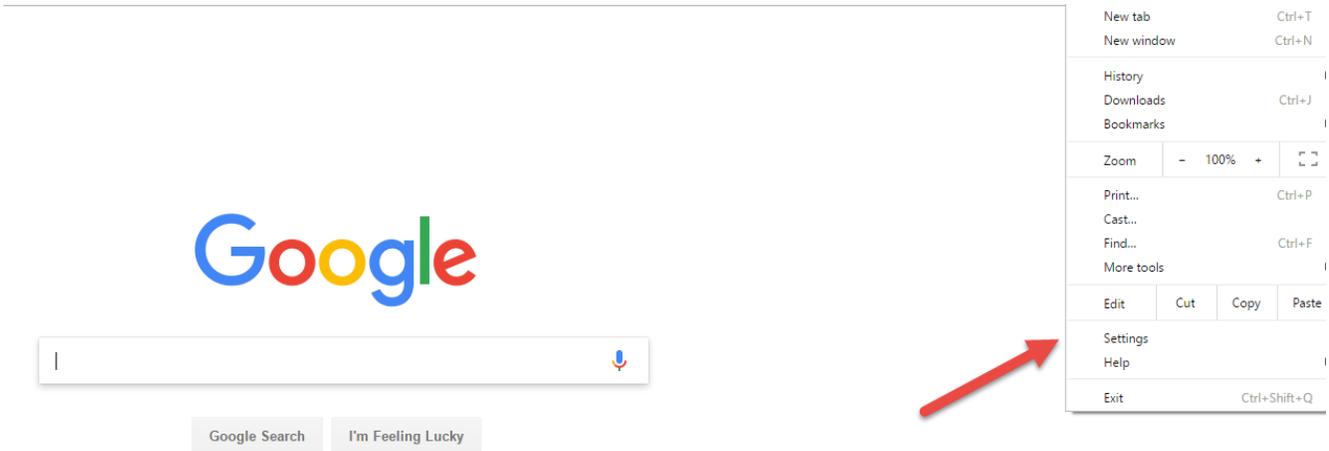
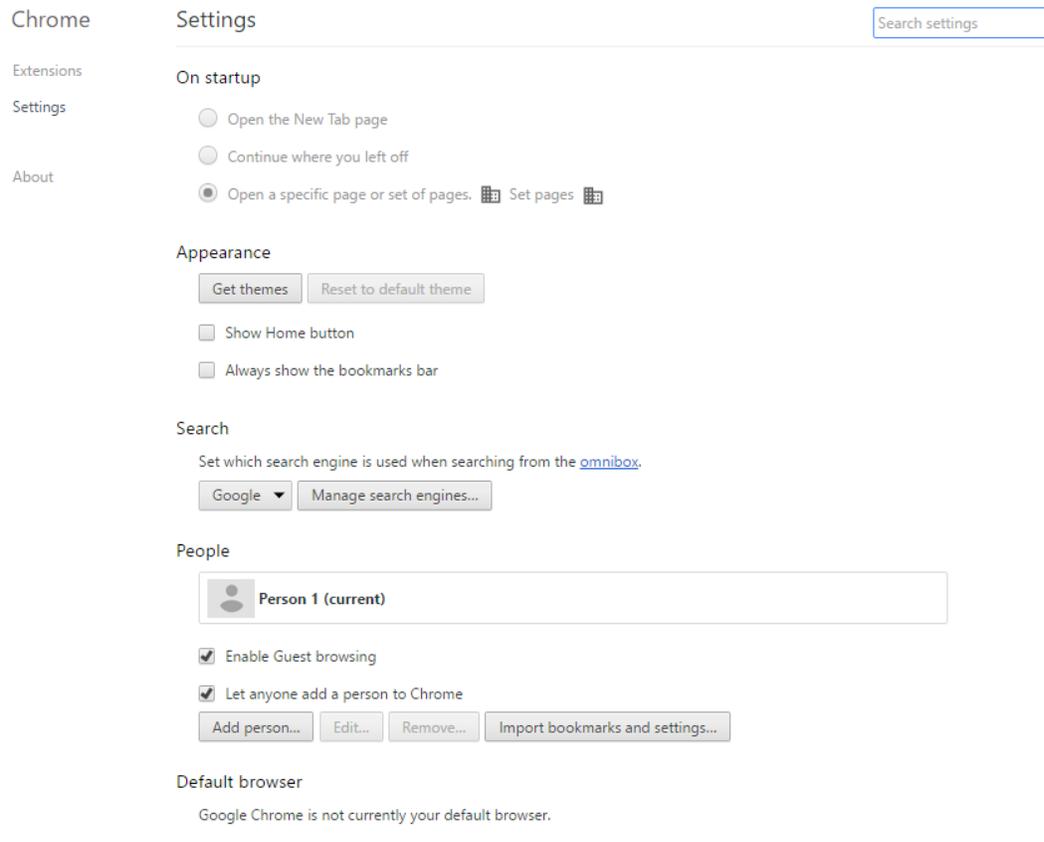


# HOW TO OPEN PDF FORMS IN CHROME

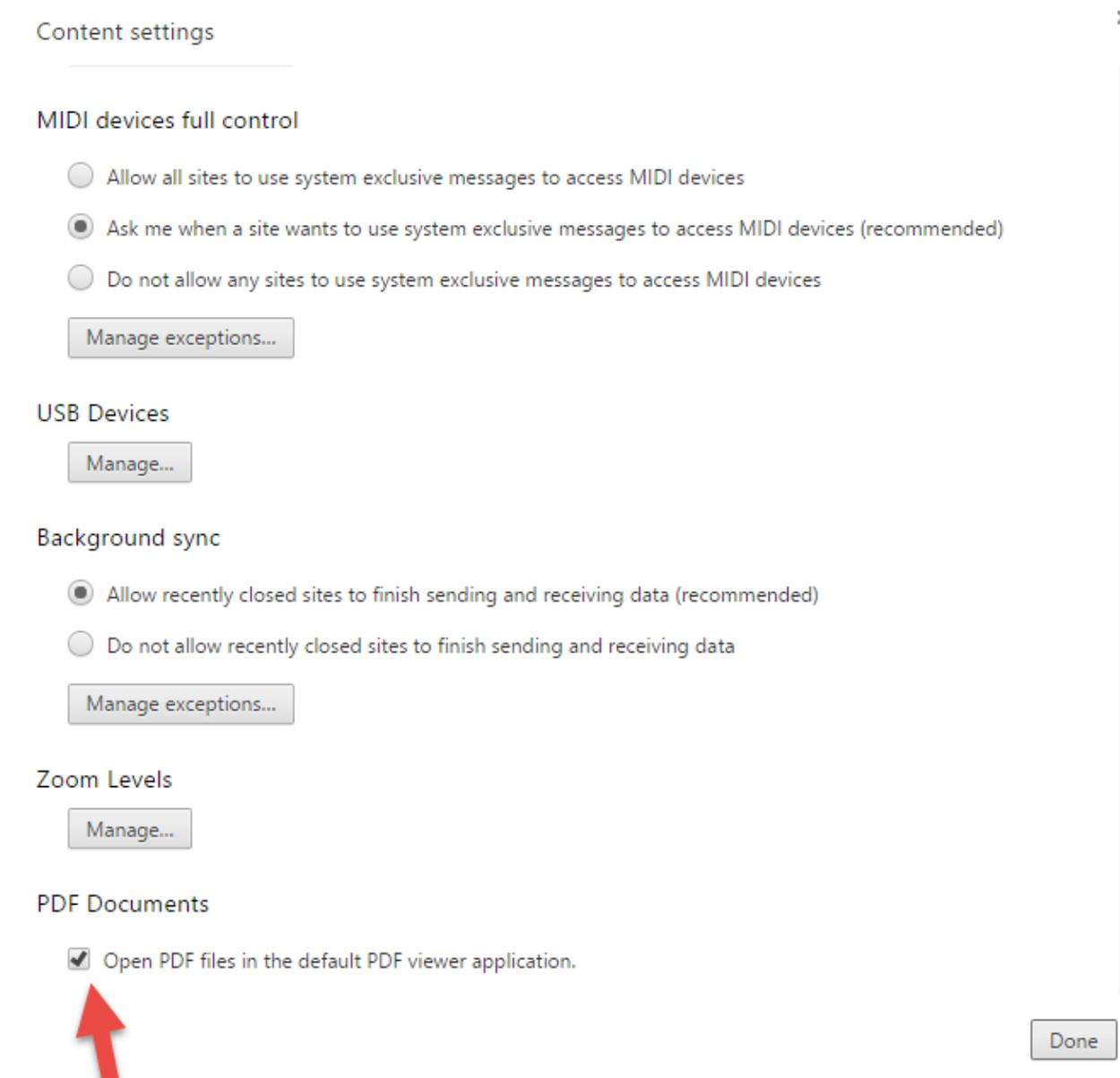
